Travel information

The CESSDA Expert Seminar 2016 (CES2016) is hosted by the Czech Social Science Data Archive (CSDA) of the Institute of Sociology AS CR on 13 (PM) and 14 (AM) September 2016. It will take place in the CERGE-EI residence, located in the centre of Prague nearby Prague Main Railway Station (Praha Hlavní nádraží).

Venue

CERGE-EI (Národohospodářský ústav AV ČR), Politických věznů 7, Prague 1

Accomodation

The venue is located in the city centre within walking distance from many hotels and with stations to all three lines of the Prague Metro nearby. It is therefore also easy to reach from further locations. September being the high tourist season, we recommend you to reserve a hotel room as soon as possible. If you require any assistance in making your reservation, please contact us.

By airplane

Transport from the airport

- Bus number 119: Prague Airport Nádraží Veleslavín (Metro A) 15 min
 After you get to Metro take a train to a metro station close to your hotel or the venue.
- Airport Taxi: Departure points are displayed in front of the arriving halls.
- Airport Express bus: Goes to Prague Main Train Station (metro line C) 35 min
- Shuttle bus to the city centre: Prague Airport V Celnici, close to Nám. republiky (Metro B)

How to buy public transportation tickets

- Public Transportation counters are placed in the arrival halls of Terminals 1 and 2, and ticket machines are placed at bus stops (cash required); you can also buy a ticket from the bus driver (small change required).
- To travel anywhere in the city by via public transportation within 90 minutes, a "Basic" ticket is suitable and costs 32 CZK.
- Tickets for the Airport Express bus can be bought only from the bus driver (higher price).

By train

- Metro station Mustek (Metro A green line or Metro B yellow line)
- Metro station Muzeum (Metro C red line or Metro A green line)
- Metro station Hlavní nádraží (Main Train Station) (Metro C red line)

By tramway

• Tramway indicated with numbers 3, 9, 14, 24 – stop Václavské náměstí or Jindřišská
